To the Parents:

Thank you for your continued support during the past three months. We recognize this has been a very difficult time for our families and we want to express our profound gratitude to each and every one of you for the incredible work you have done to support your students during this unprecedented period.

In light of the current instructions given on March 18, 2020 from the Executive Council of the Nation of Islam and more recently, the City of Richmond's announcement and discussions with our Student Regional Director, Sister Stephanie Muhammad concerning school scheduling for the upcoming 2020-2021 academic year, please find Muhammad University of Islam No. 24 Plan Of Action:.

- 1. Students (Grades 3-12 ONLY):
 - a. Virtual school will continue for the First Trimester until further instructions are given. To continue to offer virtual school to enrolled students unable to physically attend school for the remainder of the 2020-2021 academic year.
 - b. Tuition will remain at the proposed rate offered for onsite education, as these are the most minimum rates to address all of MUI financial obligations.
 - c. Tuition will be paid at the beginning of the trimester, for example: Sister Malika's tuition for the 2020-2021 is \$1533 divided by 3 trimesters, \$511 is due not later than September 8, 2020. Contact Sister Zatima X with questions concerning tuition & fees.
 - d. Online Learning will be Monday- Thursday 8AM-1PM to include 2- 10 minute breaks
 - e. Virtual school students are to register to begin July 6, 2020
 - f. Parents experiencing financial hardships are encouraged to contact me asap.
- 2. Students NOT enrolling in the MUI#24 virtual school:
 - a. Parents of students in grades K-12 are encouraged to use previous assignments, <u>Farrakhan Factor</u>, Virginia Department of Education <u>VDOE</u> and a multitude of online resources to enhance and continue building your student's intellect.
 - b. Accounts must be brought current not later than Friday, July 17, 2020, as, "my word is my bond and I will give my life before my word shall fail", all pre-existing contracts are binding.
 - c. Are to turn-in MUI textbooks and materials not later than Friday, July 17, 2020 to allow for 1st & 2nd Semester makeup assignments and continued student learning.
 - d. After the deadline textbooks and materials costs will be assessed and added to the parent's final bill.
